

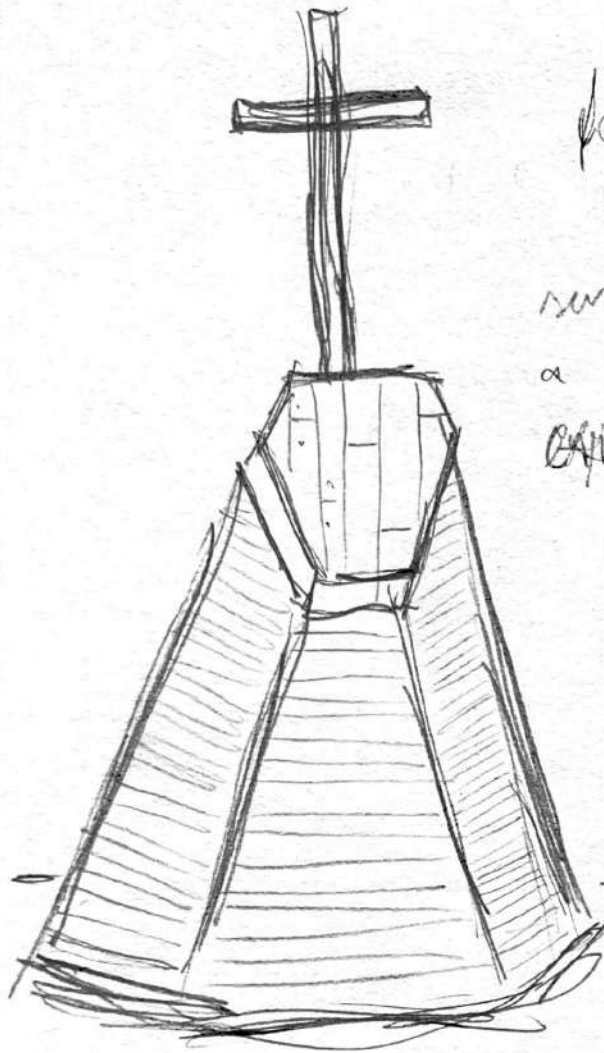
lots of on ground

still surprising)



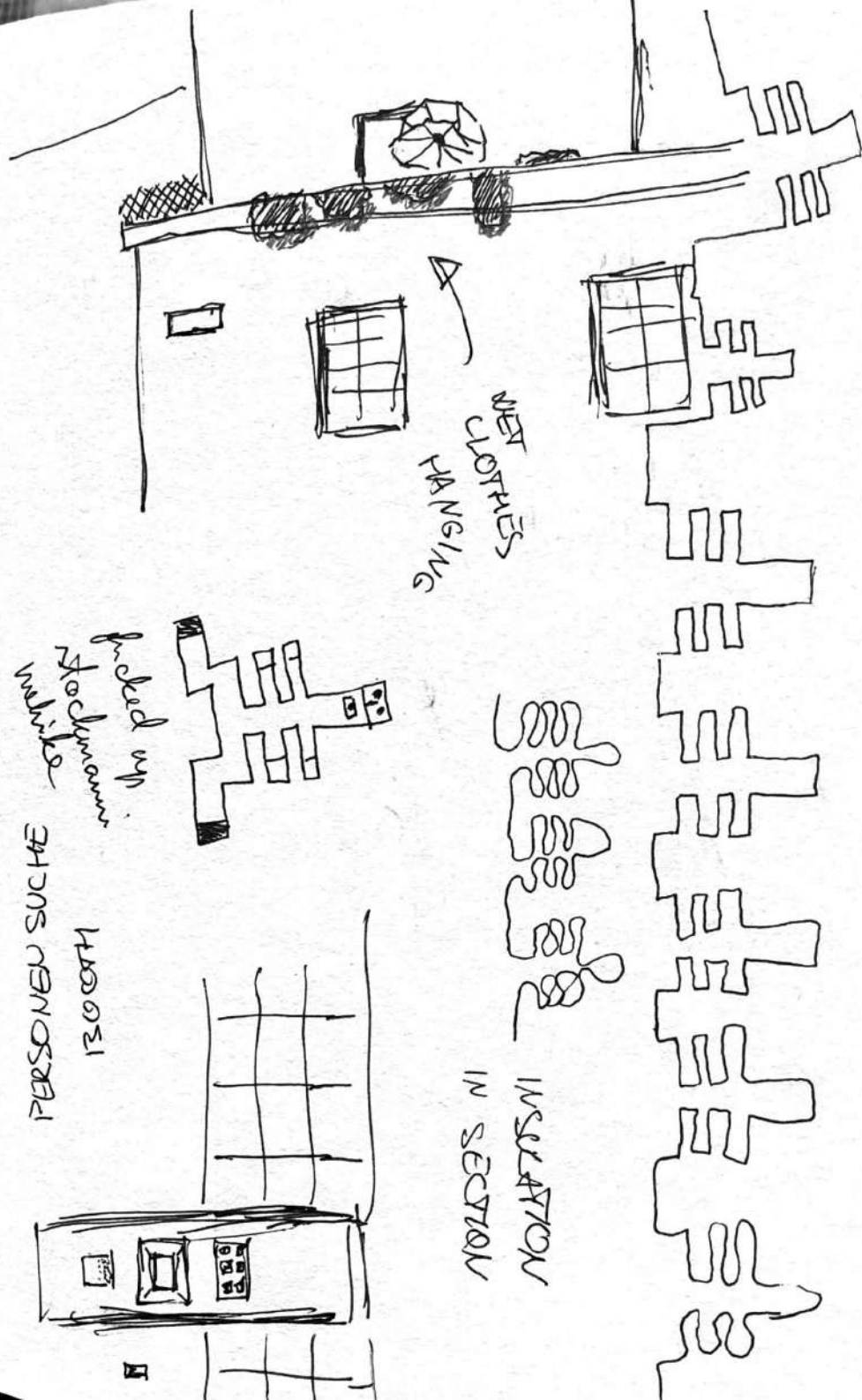
i'm really

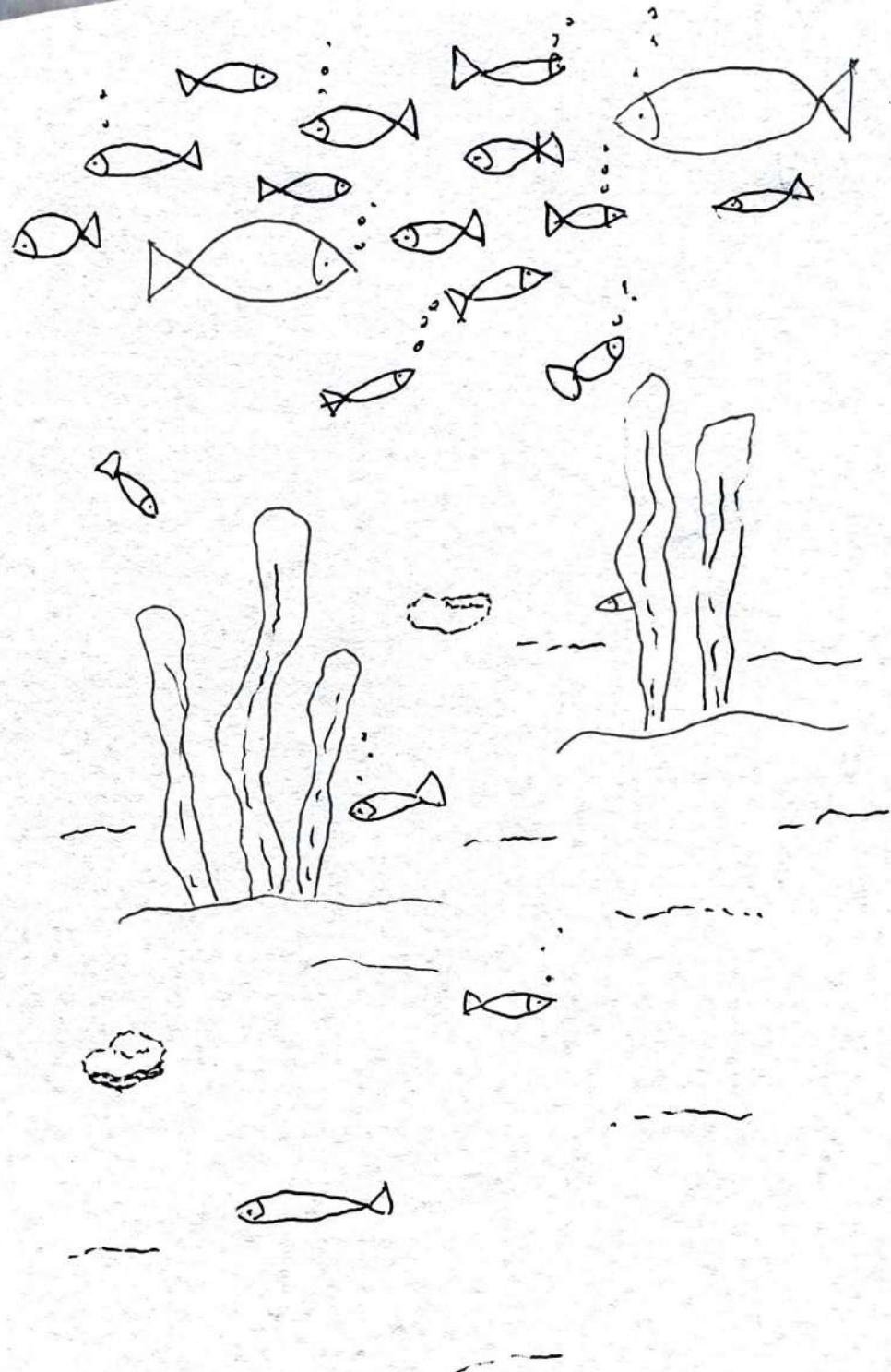
